

Recognising our 4 Returns

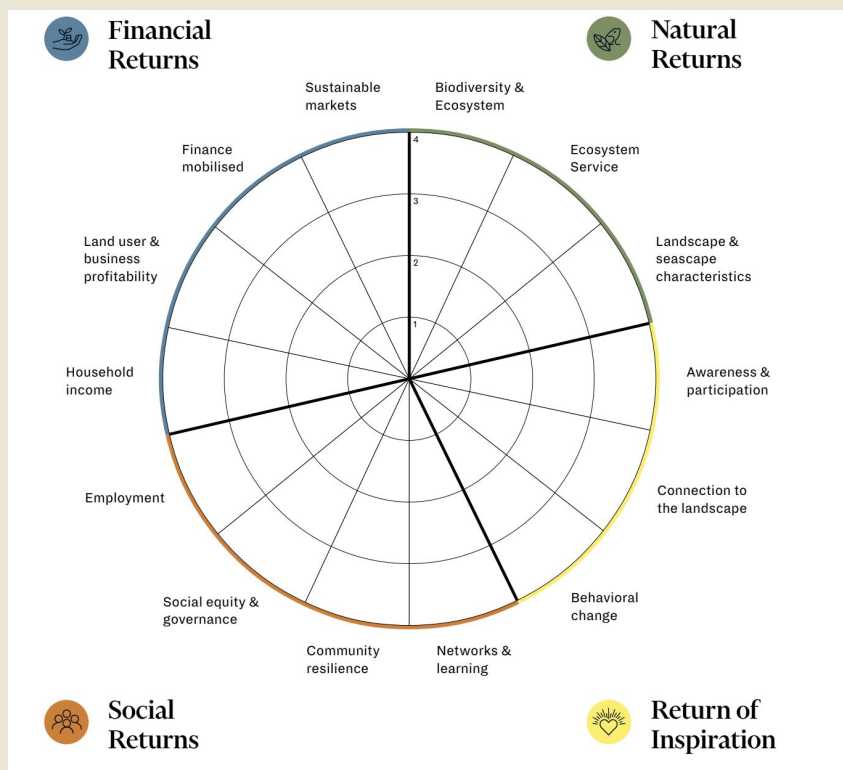
